TEPAR Application Process

- 1. You must apply to TEPAR by semester deadline **prior** to semester registering for TEPAR restricted courses as long as you have met all the TEPAR requirements*:
 - a. 2.5 overall GPA
 - b. Communications 130 with grade of C or higher
 - c. English 105 and English 115 with grade of C or higher
 - d. Passing scores on PRAXIS Core Academic Skills in Reading, Writing, and Math or an ACT composite score of 22 or higher or or a SAT combined verbal/critical reading and math score of 1100 or higher (New SAT) or 1030 or higher (pre-March 2016 SAT).
 - e. Completion of 45 semester hours or more
- 2. You must have an active TaskStream account to submit a TEPAR application. Go to www.taskstream.com to set up an account. TaskStream is a subscription-based. A credit or debit card is required to set up an account. Enroll in the TEPAR Application DRF with the code assigned to the semester (i.e. TEPARFALL2020).
- 3. Upload all the required documentation and complete all questions. Do not submit the TEPAR application until ALL of your information is completed.
- 4. Your application will be reviewed by the TEPAR Committee following the semester deadline. You will be notified of the application status via TaskStream message.

- 6. Semester deadlines for applications are posted on MOODLE/Undergrad Education page.
- *You *must* be admitted to TEPAR **prior** to advisement for registration in TEPAR restricted courses.
