#### TEACHER EDUCATION PROGRAM: ADMISSION & RETENTION

1. In order to be admitted to TEPAR: Teacher Education Program Admission and Retention and take 300 and 400-level courses in education, the following criteria must be met:
  - a. Admission to LSUS
  - b. Completion of COMM 130/135, ENGL 105 and ENGL 115 with grades of "C" or better.
  - c. Overall GPA of 2.2
  - d. Completion of 45 semester hours
2. Completion of all materials and methods courses is required **PRIOR** to enrollment in ED 422 Clinical Practice - Student Teaching.

*Admission to the Program by application through the Teacher Education Program Admission and Retention (TEPAR) Committee is required prior to enrollment in any 300 or 400-level course in education. All Praxis exams must be successfully completed prior to Residency I.*
